Cookie Policy

We would like to inform you about the types of cookies used on our website, the purposes for which cookies are used, and the settings, management and the deletion of those cookies.

What is Cookie?

Cookies are small pieces of text files stored to your computer or mobile device through your browser when you visit a site. Besides allowing a site to work more efficiently, cookies also allow presenting personalized pages in order to provide a more convenient and faster visit experience for your personal needs. Cookies only contain information about your visit history and do not collect any information regarding the files stored on your computer or mobile device.

Types of Cookies and Purposes

There are two types of cookies according to the duration of the cookie: Session Cookies and Permanent Cookies. Session cookies are formed when you visited the site and valid only until you close your browser. Permanent cookies are formed when you visited the website, however remains valid until you delete them or they are expired. For purposes such as providing you a personalized experience compatible with your settings, permanents cookies are used.

The types of cookies that are used on our website and their purposes are explained below.

Types of Cookies Used On Our Website

Session Cookies	Session cookies are temporary cookies that are used for the duration of our visitors' visit to the Website and are deleted after the browser is closed. The main purpose for the use of such cookies is to ensure the proper function of the Website during your visit. For example; it ensures that you are able to fill out online forms consisting of multiple pages.
Permanent Cookies	Permanent cookies are used to increase the functionality of the Website and to provide a faster and better service to our visitors. These types of cookies are used to remember your preferences and are stored on your device via browsers. Some types of permanent cookies can be used to provide you with specialized recommendations taking into account the purpose of your use of the Website. With the help of the permanent cookies, in the event that you visit our Website with the same device, whether there is a cookie previously formed by our Website on your device will be checked. If there is, it is understood that you have visited the site before and the content to be sent to you will be determined accordingly, thus providing you with a better service.

The Cookies Used On Our Website

rc::a	This cookie is used in order to differentiate between humans and bots. This is useful for the websites to generate valid reports on the use of the website.
rc::b	This cookie is used in order to differentiate between humans and bots.
rc::c	This cookie is used in order to differentiate between humans and bots.
_GRECAPTCHA	This cookie is used in order to differentiate between humans and bots. This is useful for the websites to generate valid reports on the use of the website.
CookieConsent	Stores the user's cookie content status for the current valid domain.
utma	Collects data on the number of visits by the user to the website, as well as the first visit and last visit dates. Used by Google Analytics.
utmb	Records a timestamp that shows exactly when the user accessed to the website. Used by Google Analytics in order to determine the duration of a website visit.
utmc	Records a timestamp that shows exactly when the user left the website. Used by Google Analytics in order to determine the duration of a website visit.
utmt	Used in order to reduce the speed of requests to the server.
utmv	Saves the user defined tracking parameters to be used in the Google Analytics.
utmz	Saves the user defined tracking parameters to be used in the Google Analytics. Collects data on where the user came from, which search engine is used, which link is clicked and which search term was used. Used by Google Analytics.

_fbp	Used by Facebook to present a range of advertising products, such as real-time bidding from third party advertisers.
r/collect	This cookie is used to send data to Google Analytics about the visitor's device and behavior. Tracks the visitor across devices and marketing channels.

How to Collect Cookies?

Data are collected through your devices from which you access browsers. These collected information are device specific; can be deleted by the user at any time and access to the information can be closed.

How Can You Manage Cookies?

You can delete the cookies already stored on your device and prevent the saving/storage of cookies on your browser.

Internet browsers are predefined to automatically accept cookies. Since managing cookies differs for each browser, you can refer to the help menu of the browser or the application for further details.

For example;

You can manage your cookies with "Google Chrome -> Settings -> Advanced -> Privacy and Security -> Site Settings -> Cookies and Site Data -> Allow sites to store and access cookie data"

You can manage with "Internet Explorer -> Settings -> Internet Options -> Privacy -> Advanced Settings"

To manage cookies through you mobile device;

For Apple devices;

- You can clean your browser history and cookies by following steps: "Settings -> Safari
 Clear History and Website Data"
- In order to delete the cookies but keep the history you can follow: "Settings -> Safari
 -> Advances -> Website Data -> Remove All Website Data"
- If you do not want the history data to be kept while visiting the sites, you may activate incognito mode by following steps: "Safari -> symbol -> Private -> Done"

• You can prevent cookies by following steps: "Settings -> Safari -> Block All Cookies" However, when you block cookies, some websites and features may not work properly.

For Android devices;

- You can clean your cookies by following steps: "Chrome application -> Settings -> Privacy -> Clear browsing data -> Cookies, media licenses and site data -> Clear data"
- You can allow or prevent cookies by option "Chrome Application -> Settings -> Site Settings -> Cookies"
